REPORTS OF FREEHOLDERS

Freeholder Kenneth Armwood

Freeholder Kenneth Armwood reported that the Middlesex County Vocational Technical High School students are undertaking a biomedical issue by researching if dental care contributes to a person's likelihood of

becoming diabetic. Endocrinologists and pediatricians have been involved in developing a survey to find out if children with better healthcare are less likely to become diabetic. Freeholder Armwood also announced that the Cultural and Heritage Commission is celebrating Presidents' Day on February 15 at 1 pm and 3 pm with a visit by John Adams, portrayed by Joe Doyle. This performance will be held at East Jersey Olde Towne Village and is offered free of charge; however registration is required by contacting 732-745-3030.

Freeholder Deputy Director Carol Barrett Bellante

Freeholder Barrett Bellante was absent this evening.

Freeholder Charles Kenny

Freeholder Charles Kenny stated that we are in a "holding pattern" waiting for the State to review and approve our budget, which will hopefully occur by March.

Freeholder H. James Polos

Freeholder H. James Polos welcomed back Freeholder Tomaro to the dais and reminded everyone that the Office of Emergency Management has designated warming centers in the event of power outages. Freeholder Polos added that we are very fortunate to have so many dedicated volunteers affiliated with our Office of Emergency Management. Freeholder Polos added that the County Fire Marshal's Office has been very busy with a number of significant fires recently-one in New Brunswick and one in Piscataway-and the Fire Marshal's Office is working on increasing its educational programs for the community and commended the dedicated firefighters who work in all weather extremes. Freeholder Polos stated that our Division of Solid Waste Management is looking into ways to fund our electronic waste recycling program which has been impacted due to recent State cutbacks. Freeholder Polos added that the Department of Environmental Protection would like old technology to be recycled at big-box stores.

Freeholder Polos reported that the Re-Entry Task Force had a very productive meeting last week and will be creating a new master plan for people leaving the Adult Correction Center and rejoining society. Freeholder Polos stated that the group will be coming up with a formal report within the next 90 days or so.

Freeholder Charles E. Tomaro

Freeholder Charles E. Tomaro reminded everyone that winter is here and driving can be difficult. Freeholder Tomaro thanked the employees of the Parks and Roads Offices for their hard work in clearing the roads after recent snowstorms. We are very proud of the excellent work these employees do whenever they are needed. Freeholder Tomaro commented

on the recent fire at the Edison Township Public Works garage last week which resulted in the loss of a significant amount of heavy equipment, including snow removal equipment. Middlesex County assisted Edison Township during last Sunday's snowstorm by plowing 22 miles of Edison roads with County equipment. Freeholder Tomaro offered his sincere thanks to all involved in finding creative ways to help Edison during this crisis. Thanks, too, to Director Rios, John Pulomena and the rest of the Freeholder Board to make sure this assistance was provided.

Freeholder Tomaro reminded us that snow can be fun, too, by visiting our County Parks for sledding in Donaldson Park and cross-country skiing along the Middlesex Greenway and other locations. Please visit the County's Parks and Recreation page on our new website to get more details on ways to have fun in the snow! In closing, Freeholder Tomaro thanked everyone for their good wishes, concern and support during his recuperation.

Freeholder Blanquita B. Valenti

Freeholder Blanquita B. Valenti commented on a recent article in the newspaper regarding homeless individuals and stated that on January 28, despite the impending winter storm, Middlesex County held its annual Point in Time Homeless Count and Project Homeless Connect as planned. There were three sites where homeless or near homeless people could go to take the Point in Time survey, get a hot meal, receive information on available services, select an article of winter clothing and take a shower if so desired. The Board of Chosen Freeholders extends its great appreciation to the many volunteers, service agencies, donors, municipal partners, police departments and the three host sites - Elijah's Promise in New Brunswick, The Salvation Army and Cathedral CDC Social Services in Perth Amboy for partnering with us on this important project. The data collected through the Point in Time count will move us forward in reaching our goal of ending homelessness in our County.

Freeholder Valenti continued her report by stating that MCFOODS recently released its 2014 annual report which announced the collection and distribution of just under 741 tons of nonperishable foods and necessities in 2014. This was a significant increase from the 529 tons collected in 2013. In addition, MCFOODS received \$27,000 in monetary donations that was used to purchase items needed throughout the year. Freeholder Valenti added that each week the MCFOODS warehouse distributes the donated food to food pantries, soup kitchens and social service agencies. Approximately 80 different agencies participate in the distribution annually. It is this collaboration among agencies, along with the generosity of individuals and groups throughout the County that allows us to help our neighbors who are hungry. I want to thank the MCFOODS

team, along with all of the people who contributed to its efforts, for their tremendous commitment and community spirit. Please maintain this spirit in 2015, so that we can continue to provide nutritious food to those who need it most.

Freeholder Director Ronald G. Rios

Director Ronald G. Rios announced that this year's Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Walk will be held on Saturday, May 30 in Johnson Park and we've had our first planning meeting. Director Rios stated that he attended the State of the Township address presented by Woodbridge Mayor John McCormac. Director Rios also asked all County residents to support one of our East Brunswick residents, Jax, in her pursuit on American Idol. We wish her the best of luck!
