REPORTS OF FREEHOLDERS

Freeholder Kenneth Armwood

Freeholder Kenneth Armwood introduced Jesus Juarez and Taharon Royer of the Urban Youth Program who made a presentation to the Freeholders about the various programs of their group which are designed to build leadership skills, such as public speaking, event planning and organizing and networking. On April 18 the group participated in a clean cities block program where two tons of trash was collected from various areas of New Brunswick. Freeholder Armwood introduced Laura Bovitz and

Laura Eppinger who are very involved in this group's activities. Freeholder Armwood concluded his report by stating that the Cultural and Heritage Commission has staged a new exhibit at the Low House entitled "History of New Jersey Diners" which will run from April 12 through June 26, 2016

Freeholder Deputy Director Carol Barrett Bellante

Freeholder Carol Barrett Bellante reported that the Middlesex County Election Board would like to announce that Jim Vokral, Administrator of the Board of Elections, was recently re-elected as Executive Vice President of the New Jersey Association of Election Officials. We offer our congratulations to Jim as he continues in this important role. Freeholder Barrett Bellante stated that as of March 30 the Middlesex County Improvement Authority will be going to single-stream collection for the 14 participating municipalities. This eliminates the need to separate recyclables which is more convenient for our residents. Freeholder Barrett Bellante added that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection ranked Middlesex County number 1 in recycling this year, which is thanks to everyone's participation and means that 65 percent of the total waste stream is recycled here. Since 1995, this is the fifth time that Middlesex County has received this distinction. It should be noted that our annual goal is 60 percent and this is the 16th time that goal has been exceeded.
