As we just heard, tonight we adopted 3 capital improvement bond ordinances that will continue to enhance our existing infrastructure.

**Ordinance 411, 412, 413 & 415** focus on the County's educational system.

- Funding provided for various campuses of our Vocational School District:
  - Replacing and repairing various depleted roofs at various schools
  - Renovate Science Labs
  - Security Improvements
  - Repaving parking lots
- For Middlesex County College these ordinances will provide monies to:
  - Begin the renovation of student labs
  - Minor Capital infrastructure projects to maintain existing buildings
- By adopting these ordinances we continue to stand firm in our commitment to offer the highest quality education to our students, because the cornerstone of a great community is top-notch education.
- **In addition** we continue to issue these bonds under our AAA rating umbrella, this results in direct savings for the County's tax payers, by paying lower interest rates.
  - These savings allow the County to undertake & fund additional capital improvements not otherwise possible.
  - It is estimated that in the last 15 years, the County saved over \$35 million dollars by having the highest rating possible

Freeholder Valenti reported that the Veterans Services Program in the county's Office of Human Services has been selected to participate in a panel at the 2015 Annual Conference of the National Coalition for Homeless Veterans, May 27<sup>th</sup> through 29<sup>th</sup>, in Washington, D.C. Our staff will present the County's award-winning VHAP (Veterans Housing Assistance Program) as part of a panel entitled "Case Studies of Internal Change". Staff will discuss how VHAP addresses service gaps, its sustainability, successes and barriers. The panel will also include representatives from the Palo Alto, California VA who will discuss their Lean Management process, and staff from the Veterans Resource Centers of America in Santa Rosa, CA, who will share best practices in developing case notes for all levels of case management.

Participating Veterans Services' staff include: Bridget Kennedy, Director of Social Work Services and manager for Veterans Services; Doug Breen, Veterans Services Coordinator and Veterans Interment Officer; and Henry Busby, Veterans Housing Specialist.
