Accessible Service:


- Monday through Saturday except on holidays noted on the holiday schedule.
- Passengers are responsible for all bags and packages brought on MCAT vehicles. Items must be carried on the vehicle in one boarding by the person belonging to the items in question. The lift will not be deployed to load any items. Agency policy prohibits drivers from assisting passengers with any items. **Individuals must be in compliance with these guidelines to board MCAT vehicles. Expect drivers to deny transportation if not in compliance.**
- Bus times are approximate.
- MCAT, offers curb to curb services for senior citizens and people with disabilities. Reservations can be requested by calling: 1-800-221-3520.
- Passengers boarding and disembarking beyond Walmart will be charged \$2.00/\$1.00 for seniors and people with disabilities.
- Timetable can be obtained in alternate formats upon request.
- If your stop is between 2 designated time points, you can flag the vehicle at safe locations for the bus to pull off the road.

SUGGESTED FARE:

- General Public: \$1.00
- Senior Citizens and People with Disabilities: \$.50
- Customers are required to have exact fare when boarding buses on this line. One dollar bills and most coins are accepted.
