

## **MCFOODS Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic**

During this unprecedented health crisis many more Middlesex County residents are in need of food assistance. With many or most schools closed, senior centers closed, and many businesses closing or reducing hours, children and seniors are without meals and working families are without paychecks and money to maintain their families.

MCFOODS is doing our best to provide extra supplies to our partners but we need your help. Any and all food donations are welcome – our staff is still available to provide containers and pick up donations and we are also accepting donations at our warehouse on weekday mornings. Donations can be dropped off at 28 Kennedy Boulevard, Suite 850, East Brunswick (side door towards the back or bay door around the back of the building) between 6 am and 12 noon.

Through our partnership with Feeding Middlesex County we are also buying supplies from local distributors. Monetary donations to [Feeding Middlesex County](https://www.feedingmiddlesexcounty.org) (<https://www.feedingmiddlesexcounty.org>) will also allow us to keep our shelves stocked.

MCFOODS is taking every precaution for our staff and volunteers to keep a safe working distance and clean work surfaces. Our partner pantries are still open and distributing to residents in need, many taking precautions like providing drive up service or limiting the number of guests in at any given time.
