



New Brunswick Landing is a floating dock that provides occasional docking facilities for area boaters and, via an overpass, direct pedestrian access to the downtown sections of New Brunswick. Only 11 nautical miles from Raritan Bay, this well-designed modular dock is capable of responding to the tidal changes in the river while offering slips for boats up to 45 feet in length. Closed circuit cameras and dock attendants are available during operating hours to monitor your boat for security.

A pleasant five to seven minute walk brings visitors to the heart of New Brunswick's thriving commercial and historic districts.
