BASIC RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Operators shall display on their back a flying field permit issued by the Middlesex County Office of Parks and Recreation. Completion of a proficiency test is required prior to the issuance of a flying permit. Clubs and permit holders must provide proof of required insurance coverage.
2. Four (4) aircrafts are allowed in the air at a time.
3. Flying times are limited to fifteen (15) minutes when someone is waiting to fly.
4. Engines shall not exceed a reading of 98db at nine (9) feet. Spot checks will be conducted by Middlesex County and any violation of this rule will subject the violators to the penalties prescribed in Rule 9.
5. Pursuant to Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) rules, all model aircraft must be registered with the FAA. Registration information is available at: <https://www.faa.gov/uas/registration/> Registration number must be present on all aircraft.
6. The established flight line and all operating boundaries of the flying field must be observed.
7. Fixed wing engine powered aircraft are to have first priority— Helicopters may be flown only when fixed wing engine powered aircraft are not flown or there is no desire to fly same.
8. Flying period for powered aircraft is 10:00AM to DUSK. Non-powered aircraft are allowed between 7:30AM and 10:00AM, or when no power aircraft are being flown.
9. At all times observance of rules and regulations of the Middlesex County Office of Parks and Recreation, Academy of Model Aeronautics, and flying clubs is mandatory.
10. Failure to observe rules and regulations will result in:
 - First Offense: Suspension of flying privileges for one (1) month.
 - Second Offense: Suspension of flying privileges for one (1) year.
