Chairman Vaughn called the meeting of the Planning Board to order at 3:30 p.m. in compliance with the Open Public Meeting Act.

Moment of Silence.

The Secretary called the roll, and it was determined that a quorum was present.

I. Open Public discussion on resolutions listed on this agenda only – None

Mr. Wong motioned to close the public portion, seconded by Freeholder Director Rios. Motion was carried unanimously.

II. Administration:

A. Approve Minutes of January 14, 2020.

Mr. Greenfeld reported that the minutes of the January 14, 2020 meeting are in the folder for approval.

Mr. Wong moved, seconded by Mr. Pollando, to approve the minutes of December 10, 2019. Freeholder Director Rios abstained. Motion was carried.

B. Review of Minutes of February 11, 2020.

Mr. Greenfeld reported that the minutes of February 11, 2020 are before the Planning Board for review and for approval at the March 10, 2020 meeting.

C. Financial Report –

Mr. Greenfeld reported that the Financial Report for January and February 2020 is before the Planning Board for approval, the 2020 proposed budget is pending adoption by the Board of Chosen Freeholders.

Mr. Pollando moved, seconded by Freeholder Director Rios, to approve the Financial Report for January and February 2020. Motion was carried unanimously.

E. Summary of Zoning and Master Plan Revisions - Mr. Greenfeld stated that the Summary of Zoning and Master Plan Revisions report is in the folder for review.

Mr. Greenfeld stated that on the Summary of Zoning and Master Plan Revisions report the ordinances for Old Bridge, Sayreville and South Brunswick are under review.

Mr. Pollando moved , seconded by Freeholder Director Rios, to approve the Summary of Zoning and Master Plan Revisions report. Motion was carried unanimously.

III. Environmental Sustainability:
Mr. Jason Freidman

A. Committee Report for February 2020:

Ms. Becker reported that the Water Quality Management Plan: Staff has met with Plainsboro and NJDEP to ensure that the County's build-out methodology is implemented on behalf of Plainsboro Township.

Water Quality Management Plan Amendment:

The Frankie Scotto Property, Block 37, Lot 12.14, South Brunswick Township, Middlesex County, was considered by the Board of Chosen Freeholders at their Public Meeting on February 6, 2020. The amendments rescheduled for a Public Hearing for March 18, 2020.

The Cranbury-Dey Road will be considered by the Board of Freeholders at their Public Meeting on March 5, 2020.

The County Agriculture Development Board has two open PIG applications for farmland preservation: (1) the Estate of Anthony Zimbicki, Sr., Monroe; and (2) the Estate of Ernest Bergfelder, East Brunswick.

There are currently four (4) right to farm applications before the County Agricultural Development Board: three (3) applications for mulching; one (1) application for a horse auction site allegedly to be operating horse rodeo events.

Ms. Becker stated that the Destination 2040 staff met regarding the current chapters; the discussion was to further refine each chapter.

Mr. Wong moved, seconded by Mr. Pollando, to approve the Committee Report for January 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

IV. Transportation:
Mr. Ronald Sendner, County Engineer

A. Committee Report for January 2020:

Mr. Gambilonghi stated that the 2013 revised Transit Guide has been updated and is under review by Keep Middlesex Moving and NJ Transit.

Mr. Gambilonghi reported that the NJTPA regional sessions for the FY2021-2023 Congestion Mitigation Air Quality was held on January 16, 2020. This program included alternative fuel transit vehicles and fueling infrastructure, shuttle vehicles replacement, bike lane, greenway facilities, intersection and traffic signal movements, shuttle vehicle replacements and traveler information services.

The Livingston Avenue Complete Street Project; Mr. Sendner stated that the construction has already started and will take approximately one half year to complete.

The Central Jersey Transportation Forum was held on February 4, 2020. Mr. Greenfeld, Mr. Ververides and I attended. A resolution to adopt Vision Zero goal that there be no loss of life due to traffic crashes was accepted.

Mr. Gambilonghi stated that the Destination 2040 staff met regarding the comments received by the stakeholders regarding several hundred comments; the discussion was to further review all related goals for each chapter.

Mr. Pollando addressed the Sayreville Bus Line. He stated that a Committee and the "New" Mayor were in discussion regarding the number of Sayreville Residents commuting to NYC.

Mr. Pollando invited Mr. Caviness, Transportation Department Head, to attend a meeting to discuss options for the residents.

Mr. Gambilonghi stated that the Academy Bus Line was eliminated because of the low ridership use. We are unable to determine where the passengers reside, to help determine a new bus route.

Mr. Wong moved, seconded by Mr. Pollando, to approve the Committee Report for January, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.
