Certificate of Insurance Requirements

The County of Middlesex carries insurance covering its legal liability. The County of Middlesex assumes no liability with respect to bodily injury, property damage, illness or any other damages or losses, or with respect to any claims arising out of any activity of the permit holder.

The County of Middlesex requires the applicant to procure and continue in force for the term identified on the permit comprehensive general liability insurance with limits of \$1,000,000 combined single limit. The policy must include contractual liability coverage and name the County of Middlesex as an additional insured. The applicant shall provide the County of Middlesex with a certificate of Insurance. The Certificate of Insurance must state that the County of Middlesex is named as an additional insured and that the policy has been endorsed to include contractual liability coverage. The Certificate of Insurance shall contain a 30 day notice of cancellation. The Certificate Holder shall be identified as the Middlesex County Board of Chosen Freeholders.
