RESOLUTION OF THE MONROE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP POLICE CHIEF / OEM COORDINATOR
TO SUBMIT A STATEMENT OF THE TOWNSHIP'S
INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL
FLOOD MITIGATION PLANNING PROCESS

WHEREAS, following a July 2005 storm in which 6 to 8 inches of rain fell within one hour, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers conducted a study to determine the impact of flooding in seven (7) towns in southern Middlesex County and to determine ways to mitigate such flooding; and

WHEREAS, the Middlesex County Freeholder Board, in September 2005, by means of a Federal Grant in the amount of \$500,000.00, established the South Central Middlesex County Flood Control Commission comprised of representatives from the seven (7) towns most heavily impacted by flooding within the southern Middlesex County area, i.e. East Brunswick, Helmetta, Jamesburg, Monroe, Old Bridge, South River and Spotswood; and

WHEREAS, the County of Middlesex entered into an Agreement with the U.S. Department of Agriculture – Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) in September 2008 for the development of a preliminary watershed study to examine the nature and extent of flooding and to develop preliminary solutions for flood damage reduction; and

WHEREAS, in April 2010, through technical assistance provided by the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service and the Freehold Soil Conservation District, the Manalapan and Matchaponix Brooks Watershed Preliminary Flood Damage and Mitigation Report was published; and


WHEREAS, the Middlesex County Office of Emergency Management ("OEM") has advised that the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan ("PDMP") is scheduled for review and possible modification and the towns that comprise the South Central Middlesex County Flood Commission have the option of participating in the initiative with the Middlesex County OEM or draft their own PDMP; and

WHEREAS, participation in the multi-jurisdictional flood mitigation planning process with the Middlesex County OEM is in the best interest of the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Monroe, in the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey hereby authorizes the Township Police Chief / OEM Coordinator to submit a Statement of the Township's intent to participate in the multi-jurisdictional flood mitigation planning process with the Middlesex County OEM; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Monroe Township acknowledges and agrees to contribute to the grant funding with an in-kind match based upon hours spent,


