Composting Workshop Location (EARTH Center, 42 Riva Avenue):

Take Route 1 to Route 130 South. Stay on Route 130 for about 4 miles and make a left onto Davidson Mill Road. Make the first right onto Riva Avenue. The Park entrance is on the left. Follow entrance road all the way back until you see the new building on the right.

or
Take Route 18 to Cranbury Road (Route 535) South in East Brunswick. Make right onto Davidson Mill Road at a traffic light. Make left onto Riva Avenue (just before bridge). Park entrance is on the left. Follow entrance road all the way back until you see the new building on the right.
