No conversation is worth a ticket or your life.

It is against the law to talk on a hand-held cell phone or to text a message while driving. If a police officer observes you talking on a hand-held cell phone or sees you texting while driving, you will be **stopped, ticketed, and fined.**

Keeping both hands on the wheel and your mind focused on driving is essential for your safety and for the safety of everyone else on the road. **Motorists who talk on a cell phone or text while driving are four times more likely to be injured in a crash.** In 2009, more than 5,400 people were killed and 448,000 injured in motor vehicle crashes that involved distracted driving.

Any conversation, even on a hands-free device, is distracting, dangerous, and can delay your reaction time behind the wheel as much as driving while intoxicated with a .08 BAC. The best way to ensure your safety is to **Hang Up! Just Drive.**
